Terms & Conditions of Entry

- 1. Entry to the exhibition is open to all students and teachers of Dunstan High School past and present.
- 2. Artists may enter one or two pieces into the exhibition.
- 3. All artwork must be for sale and must stay on display for the duration of the exhibition.
- 4. Entries must be framed (a stretched canvas is considered framed) with wire or cord securely attached for hanging.
- 5. Artwork must be clearly labelled on the back with the title, medium, artists name, address, phone number, email address, artwork size.
- 6. Artists work must be delivered to the Dunstan High School drama suite between **8.30am and 4pm on or before Wednesday 17**th **Oct.** Couriered entries will be accepted at the school by arrangement with the arts coordinator Suzanne Russell in the week prior. Email arts@dunstan.school.nz
- 7. Hand delivered entries to be delivered to drama suite **Thursday 18th Oct between 8.30am and 4pm.**
- 8. ALL works to be collected from DHS drama suite on Monday 22nd Oct between 10am and 1pm.
- 9. If your artwork needs to be re-packaged and returned by courier, a courier ticket must be attached to the back of your work and be picked up before **1pm Monday 22**nd **Oct.**
- 10. A commission as set on the entry form of 20% will be deducted by Dunstan High School PTA from the exhibition price of each work sold. Artists will be notified if artwork is sold and artist payment made by arrangement with the artist and the Dunstan High School PTA.
- 11. Each entrant is responsible for maintaining their own insurance coverage. Dunstan High School art exhibition organisers will exercise reasonable care but will not be responsible for any loss or damage to submitted work while in their possession.

Important Dates

Friday 5 October – The completed form must be received before this date.

Wednesday15 October – Art work must be delivered to the DHS on or before.

Fri 19, Sat 20, Sun 21 October – Exhibition open at Dunstan High School.

Monday 22 October – Artworks collected from the drama suite before 1pm.

We would like an artist statement (no more than 100 words) to give viewers more information about you. We will print this for display alongside your work. The art exhibition is DHS PTA initiative with all commission (artist to choose the amount they wish to donate) from sales to benefit school.
