You are warmly invited to participate in our 'cash and carry' exhibition. Entries are open to all. The exhibition takes place during the Easter long weekend, running alongside the Clyde Food and Wine Harvest Festival.

Conditions of Entry

1. All artwork must be original and the sole work of the artist.
2. Giclée, photography and AI art are excluded.
3. Paintings must be mounted ready for hanging and not have any protruding screws.
4. A swing tag must be attached to each artwork stating
 - Artist's name
 - Title of the work
 - Medium
 - Price
5. Sculpture must have a plinth provided.
6. Unframed bin folder work must be laid on stiff board and be covered with cellophane. A label must be attached to the back stating
 - Artist's name
 - Title of the work
 - Medium
 - Price
7. All work must be for sale.
8. The COAS will receive a commission of 25% for every item sold.
9. Insurance is the sole responsibility of the artist.
10. Unfinished, wet work, or work that does not comply with the conditions of entry will not be displayed. COAS hanging decisions are final and no discussion will be entered into.

If available, another work will be hung in its place.</p> <p>Note: Clyde Food & Wine Festival takes place on Sunday 20 April in Main Street.</p>
